Proposed research projects should engage substantively with the Ransom Center's collections and must demonstrate a commitment to innovation and creativity, and include plans for both scholarly and community engagement.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be an Irish Citizen, or E.U. citizen living in the Republic of Ireland for the past 3+ years
- Preference will be given to current PhD students (in progress but not awarded)
- · This is a Student Award, it is not open to post-doctoral academics
- Preferred Award period: 3 consecutive months in Sept-Dec 2021 or Jan-May 2022
- Must possess leadership qualities and potential
- Must have a clear understanding of what it means to be a Fulbrighter
- Must not be a dual U.S.-Irish citizen, green card holder, or currently living in the U.S., or already have extensive experience of studying or living in the U.S.
