# **FULBRIGHT OPPORTUNITY - CYBERSECURITY**

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Must be an Irish Citizen, or E.U. citizen living in the Republic of Ireland for the past 3+ years
- Preference will be given to a Professional with 3-5 years' experience in relevant fields or early career researchers with PhD conferred since 2014
- This is a Scholar Award, it is not open to post-doctoral academics
- Must possess leadership qualities and potential
- Must have a clear understanding of what it means to be a Fulbrighter
- Must *not* be a dual U.S.-Irish citizen, green card holder, or currently living in the U.S., or already have extensive experience of studying or living in the U.S.

- Prospective Awardees must make contact with <u>gli@bc.edu</u> and request a letter of recommendation by an earlier deadline of 1 November 2018. This letter <u>must</u> be included in their Fulbright application.
- All successful applicants must comply with the two-year home rule, which means that awardees will
  not be eligible for U.S. residency or a visa until the two-year home rule in Ireland is complete.
